1.0 COURSE BACKGROUND

Most of us don't like change. Change can bring huge benefits, but unless you deal with people's real and imagined fears and concerns, most of us will try to avoid it. This course is suitable for anyone involved in change in the workplace. The course explores the things that happen before, during and after change. It offers practical tools to make potentially difficult situations more manageable.

- Use of effective communication at work places
- Change management
