1.0 COURSE BACKGROUND

Monitoring and project control are universal activities indispensable to effective and efficient operations of the project. The development of a monitoring and evaluation programme will ensure that waste of resources during project implementation is avoided, and that the project will stay on course. In the absence of a functional monitoring framework, project managers often find themselves not having control over events. Many organizations have learnt that it is important to track the progress in implementation of projects so that remedial measures can be taken in time. This course offers essential training for programme and project managers in the area of monitoring and evaluation.

2.0 COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the end of the course, participants will be able to learn:

- (1) How to use the terms of reference;
- (2) Produce evidenced based monitoring and evaluation report for decision making
- (3) How to prepare evaluation plans;
- (4) An understanding of the concepts, types and procedures of monitoring;
- (5) How to use the Logical Framework in the context of M&E;
- (6) Methodology and approaches to M&E;
- (7) How to implement the performance monitoring system;
- (8) An understanding of Impact Evaluation Study;
- (9) How to compile Project Monitoring Reports;
- (10) How to write Evaluation Reports;
- (11) How to utilize Monitoring and Evaluation Report; and
- (12) How to use data for monitoring and evaluation

3.0 TARGET PARTICIPANTS

The course is intended for project /programme officers and coordinators, managers and consultants and any one charged with the responsibility of monitoring and evaluation of projects.

4.0 METHODOLOGY

The course will be achieved through using lectures, discussions and case studies analysis.
