SHORT COURSE ANNOUNCEMENT
ON
TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS

(12th – 21st March 2019 - IAA Arusha Campus, Arusha)

1.0 Course Background

The principal role of transport is to provide access between spatially separated locations for the business and household sectors, for both commodity (freight) and person movements. For the business sector, this involves connections between businesses and their input sources, between businesses and other businesses, and between businesses and their markets. For public sector it influences patterns of growth and economic activity by providing access to land. The performance of the system affects public policy concerns like air quality, environmental resource consumption, social equity, land use, urban growth, economic development, safety, and security. For the household sector, it provides people with access to workplaces and education facilities, shops, and social, recreational, community and medical facilities.

2.0 Course Contents

At the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- a) Understand Overview of transport operations and various modes of transportation
- b) Transport Management decisions
- c) Transport costing and pricing principles
- d) Transport sector in Tanzania
- e) Institutional and regulatory framework of transport sector in Tanzania
- f) Global transport regulations
- g) International transport management and documentation
- h) Leadership and Management skills for Transport Managers

3.0 Target Group

The course is intended for Transport managers from both public and private organizations, fleet operations officers from logistics companies, Operations managers from ports authorities, managers from clearing and forwarding companies, transport policy analysts, Directors of sections/departments, and any other personnel involved in transport management.

4.0 Methodology

The training will be delivered by competent and experienced facilitators in transport, logistics and supply chain management, both from inside and outside the Institute (experienced senior transport and fleet management officers from public entities and logistics companies have been invited to join with facilitation team). The course will be conducted through lectures, discussions and case studies analysis. Participants will be offered an opportunity to refocus, refresh and rededicate.

5.0 Fees & Mode of Payment:

The fee for the course is **TZS 1,700,000/=** (say One Million Seven Hundred Thousand only) per participant to cover for tuition fee, training materials, tea/coffee, lunch and **a one day study tour to one of the National Park in Arusha**. Participants will have to arrange for their own travel, accommodation and upkeep while attending the course in Arusha.
